Minimal Facts

In their book, *The Case for the Resurrection of Jesus* (Kregal, 2004), Gary Habermas and Michael Licona list four historical facts that nearly all scholars (even skeptics) accept as reliable, plus a fifth fact that an "impressive majority" accept as reliable. A solid case can be made for the resurrection being the explanation that best explains these minimal facts.

- 1. Jesus died by crucifixion
- 2. Jesus' disciples believed that he rose from the dead and appeared to them
- 3. The church persecutor Paul was suddenly changed
- 4. The skeptic James, brother of Jesus, was suddenly changed
- 5. The tomb was empty
